I firmly believe that the Lutheran Confessions, which I have vowed to follow, are very clear that salvation is through Jesus Christ alone. I believe they are very clear that the Bible is the only authority to which all teachings and teachers are subordinate. I see the ELCA moving away from these convictions and I do not wish to do so. I fully recognize that we are brothers and sisters in Christ, and that I am not the one who will judge the conduct or beliefs of others.

It has been a privilege to serve at TVLC and I am honored to have worked with this amazing body of believers. Thank you for the many many ways you have lifted others up in Jesus' name. Marilyn and I are enormously grateful for the generosity that has been put forth in our mission together. It is my sincere hope that the future will bring many opportunities in which we can stand together in ministry to support the work of Christ in the world.

I have however decided that my Calling requires that I not continue as a pastor in the ELCA. Effective April 30, 2010; I therefore submit my resignation from the clergy roster of the ELCA and from the position of Lead Pastor and Tanque Verde Lutheran Church.

I will be joining Lutheran Congregations in Mission for Christ as a pastor on their roster and serving within that community of Christ's Church in the world.
